## Emcee(s)

### Lifestyle Expectations:

\* Each student who accepts any of the below listed positions will have upon them expectations regarding their walk with Christ, school work, homework, family time and responsibilities with 2020 Student Ministries. Parents and students will be given a copy of the individual position(s) responsibilities and expectations, that the student has requested to be a part of. One copy will have signatures for both student and parent to sign and return.

- **Vocalists - all ranges/guys and gals grades 7-12.**

The team would ideally consist of 3-4 singers, with a minimum of 2 as acceptable. Vocal ranges of all types are welcome. We wish to encourage those with gifts of singing to use them to lift the Lord and bless other students.

- **Drummer (trap set).**

The worship team utilizes the drums during worship. A trap set owned by the church / 2020 Student Ministries will be available for use. Students wishing to serve here will be required to have a level of accomplishment with this instrument to enhance the students worship time. Students with a desire to play, with little or no experience, should contact the Youth Pastor/Worship leader how we can help you.

- **Guitar (acoustic, electric and bass).**

Lead and support guitars are a big addition or foundation of worship for 2020. We welcome guitar players to this group of servants. Worship can thrive with only an acoustic guitar if needed.

- **Violin.**

The violin brings a very unique and special sound to a worship team. As with all Worship Team positions a beginning level of skill level is important. Growth and improvement comes with experience and we welcome and embrace that philosophy.

**-Keyboard/Piano.**

The keyboard/piano, along with the guitar are the backbone of the worship team. Beginners to skilled players are welcome to become a part of the Worship Team.

**-Other instruments.**
